



## **MATURE 45+ PROJECT EXPLOITATION ACTIVITIES AND USAGE OF THE PROJECT RESULTS**

Project came to it's final stage. One of the key activities at this stage is exploitation of the Project results – website and the virtual centre for the development of digital and labor skills of the adults over the age of 45.

In the previous stage of the Project the testing of this instrument disclosed it's potential functionality and provided the information for improvements.

Exploitation activities took part in the all Project partner countries and involved the participants representing the main target group of the Project – learners and job seekers over the age of 45, representatives of employment agencies, providers of career consulting services, employers, employees, adult education and training providers, regional development agencies and NGO's. During August and September 2018 there were organised exploitation seminars and workshops where the Project partners introduced the Project and explained the usage of the virtual centre, as well as disclosed the benefits of this centre for the management of employment, lifelong learning and career development activities and pathways. In total 115 participants were involved in these seminars and workshops: 61 in Sweden, 25 in Spain, 19 in Lithuania and 10 in Germany.
